Well, Tony Cointreau, a scion of the French liqueur family, can. After a successful

international singing career, and several years on the Cointreau board of directors, he felt a need for something more meaningful in his life. Then, after Tony met the iconic Broadway diva Ethel Merman, she became his mentor and second "other mother." Tony's memoir voices his opinion that he had no special gifts or talents to bring to Mother Teresa's work and that if he could do it, then anyone could do it. In the end, all that really matters is a willingness to share even a small part of oneself with others.
