In this report, the Commission provides an electronic database of the physical data needed in calculations of radionuclide-specific protection and operational

quantities. This database supersedes the data of Publication 38 (ICRP, 1983), and will be used in future ICRP publications of dose coefficients for the intake of or exposure to radionuclides in the workplace and the environment. The database contains information on the half-lives, decay chains, and yields and energies of radiations emitted in nuclear transformations of 1252 radionuclides of 97 elements. The CD accompanying the publication provides electronic access to complete tables of the emitted radiations, as well as the beta and neutron spectra. The database has been constructed such that user-developed software can extract the data needed for further calculations of a radionuclide of interest. A Windows-based application is provided to display summary information on a user-specified radionuclide, as well as the general characterisation of the nuclides contained in the database. In addition, the application provides a means by which the user can export the emissions of a specified radionuclide for use in subsequent calculations.

Analysis of Environmental Radionuclides

A three-day Symposium on Clastic Tidal Deposits was organized in Utrecht in August 1985, and attended by about 200 participants. During the meeting some 60 papers and 25 posters were presented, while simultaneously workshops on various topics were held. The meeting was generously sponsored by the International Association of Sedimentologists, the Royal Dutch I Shell Exploration and Production Laboratories, British Petroleum Company, Chevron Oil Company, and K.L.M. This volume contains extended versions of papers that were presented during the meeting, papers reporting about items studied during the excursions, and, moreover, several contributions which were solicited after the conference in order to make the volume more representative. As in most fields of sedimentological research, the comparison of recent processes and products with ancient

counterparts and vice versa is important for understanding the full sequence of processes and events that lead to the final end product of tide-influenced sedimentary environments. In this respect we are happy that recent as well as fossil sediments get ample attention. Research on tidal sedimentary processes and products has traditionally put much emphasis on siliciclastic sediments. Still, carbonate and mixed carbonate/siliciclastic sediments, though being subject to tidal influences in many places, receive little attention in this respect, which, we regret, is also reflected in this volume.

The anomalous E1 conversion; internal conversion electrons from primary fission fragments; particle parameters measured in pure transitions; and survey of E1 transitions in the rare earth region are also discussed in this book.

Chemistry of Uranium

The purpose of this book is to present a state of art summary of current knowledge of methods of assessment of radionuclides in the terrestrial and marine environments. It cover the traditional methods of radioactivity measurements such as radiometrics techniques, but also recent developments in the mass spectrometry sector. The book starts with a short preface introducing the subject of the book, summarising content and philosophy of the book, as well as the most important historical achievements. The scientific topics are introduced by description of sampling methods, optimisation of sampling sites and sampling frequency. The recent developments in radiochemical separation methods using chromatography resins for the treatment of actinides, transuranics and other groups of radioelements are also described. No other book is available covering all aspects of environmental radioactivity measurements, although remarkable progress has been made in detection techniques over the last ten years. At present the new methods enable to carry out investigations which were not possible before, either because of lack of sensitivity or because of the fact that they required too large samples.

Guidelines for Chemical Transportation Safety, Security, and Risk Management

ABSTRACT -- These revised Recommendations for a System of Radiological Protection formally replace the Commission's previous, 1990, Recommendations, and update, consolidate, and develop the additional guidance on the control of exposure from radiation sources issued since 1990. Thus, the present Recommendations update the radiation and tissue weighting factors in the quantities equivalent and effective dose and update the radiation detriment, based on the latest available scientific information of the biology and physics of radiation exposure. They maintain the Commission's three fundamental principles of radiological protection, namely justification, optimisation and the application of dose limits, clarifying how they apply to radiation sources delivering exposure and to individuals receiving exposure. The Recommendations evolve from the previous process-based protection approach using practices and interventions by moving to an approach based on the exposure situation. They recognise planned, emergency, and existing exposure situations, and apply the fundamental principles of justification and optimisation of protection to all of these situations. They maintain the Commission's current individual dose limits for effective dose and equivalent dose from all regulated sources in planned exposure situations. They re-inforce the principle of optimisation of protection, which should be applicable in a similar way

to all exposure situations, subject to restrictions on individual doses and risks: dose and risk constraints for planned exposure situations, and reference levels for emergency and existing exposure situations. The Recommendations also include an approach for developing a framework to demonstrate radiological protection of the environment. The term 'Popular Music' has traditionally denoted different things in France and Britain.
